
FALL FROM RADIO TOWER INJURES 2

Greeley, Colo. – Two males sustain injuries after falling from a radio tower north of Dacono around 2:30 pm today.

The Weld County Sheriff's Office received a call about two males who fell approximately 30 feet from a radio tower near Highway 52 and Weld County Road 17. The responding deputy reported possible ankle, leg, and back injuries. Both victims were transported by air to Denver area hospitals.

The two workers, 48 year old Charles Lovell of Denver and 24 year old Peder Mork of Denver, were completing work for Clear Channel. During this process they were suspended approximately 30 feet above the ground from a cable that was attached to the tower above them. The other end of the cable was then connected to a winch on the ground. The cable on the winch came lose and the two fell to the concrete below.

At this time there is no criminal investigation and the call is being handled as an industrial accident.
